Vanderbilt University and Vanderbilt **University Medical Center are excited to** launch a new initiative: Vanderbilt FIRST (Faculty Institutional Recruitment for Sustainable Transformation), which will help build a thriving diverse scientific faculty and a sustainable culture of inclusive excellence.

Faculty Cluster Hiring

Vanderbilt FIRST is part of NIH's FIRST Program, which helps institutions build a diverse community of scientists, through recruitment of a critical mass of early-career faculty who have a demonstrated commitment to inclusive excellence. Faculty will be recruited in several rounds of clusters of 6-7 faculty.

Who Should Apply?

Applications will be accepted from early-career scientists for tenure-track faculty positions at the Assistant Professor level. Candidates must be committed to inclusive excellence, and we strongly encourage individuals from marginalized racial and ethnic groups and other underrepresented groups to apply. We are seeking exceptional candidates with expertise in Immunology, Inflammation, and Metabolism or Neuroscience.

Eligibility

Applicants must have a PhD or MD and should not have previously held a tenure-track Assistant Professor (or equivalent level) position. Applicants should have a strong record demonstrating ability to conduct high-level research as well as a demonstrated commitment to promoting diversity and inclusive excellence.
